### Crewmember Qualification Checklist:

#### Items That Must Be Completed Prior To Dockside Oral Examination/Underway Check Ride

Mentors may use this list to help insure that a candidate has completed the necessary items prior to the dockside oral examination with a QE. Show the completed list to the QE to make prerequisite checking easier and faster.

<input type="checkbox"/>	BCM-01-04-AUX	IS100 and IS700 Incident Command System courses (must be reported manually by candidate to Cape Cod DIRAUX office for AUXDATA entry)	AUXDATA	Mentor signs this task. Make sure candidate has reported results to Cape Cod office.
<input type="checkbox"/>	BCM-08-01-AUX	Basic Knowledge of Boating Skills (completed or challenged one of the list of approved boating courses)	FSO-PE or certificate from one of the approved courses	QE signs this task given some evidence.
<input type="checkbox"/>	All mentor tasks	BCM-01-01-AUX through BCM-08-02-AUX	Signatures in qualification guide	Mentor checks that all is done.

When the above is all complete, a dockside oral examination (BCM-08-03-AUX ) can be scheduled with a QE. When the dockside oral examination is complete, an underway check ride (BCM-08-04-AUX) can be done with a QE.
